One Year Bible: Week 51

Isaiah 46:9 remember the former things of old; for I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me,

Isaiah 46:10 **declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done,** saying, ‘My counsel shall stand, and **I will accomplish all my purpose,**’

Luke 24:27 And beginning with **Moses** and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in **all the Scriptures the things concerning himself.**

Genesis

Genesis 3:21 And the LORD God made for Adam and for his wife **garments of skins and clothed them.**

Genesis 17:7 And **I will establish my covenant between me and you** and your offspring after you throughout their generations for an **everlasting covenant,** to be God to you and to your offspring after you.

Genesis 22:2 He said, “**Take your son, your only son Isaac,** whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah, and **offer him there as a burnt offering** on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you.”

Exodus

Exodus 12:5 **Your lamb shall be without blemish,** a male a year old. You may take it from the sheep or from the goats,

Exodus 12:7 “**Then they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts** and the lintel of the houses in which they eat it.

Exodus 12:13 The blood shall be a sign for you, on the houses where you are. And **when I see the blood, I will pass over you,** and **no plague will befall you to destroy you,** when I strike the land of Egypt.

1Corinthians 5:7 Cleanse out the old leaven that you may be a new lump, as you really are unleavened. **For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed.**

Numbers

Numbers 21:9 So **Moses made a bronze serpent and set it on a pole**. And if a serpent bit anyone, **he would look** at the bronze serpent **and live**.

John 3:14 And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up,

John 3:15 that **whoever believes in him may have eternal life**.

John 3:16 “For **God so loved** the world, that **he gave his only Son**, that **whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life**.”

Deuteronomy

Deuteronomy 27:26 “**‘Cursed be anyone who does not confirm the words of this law by doing them.’** And all the people shall say, ‘Amen.’”

Galatians 3:10 **For all who rely on works of the law are under a curse**; for it is written, “Cursed be everyone who does not abide by all things written in the Book of the Law, and do them.”

Galatians 3:11 Now it is evident that no one is justified before God by the law, for “The righteous shall live by faith.”

Galatians 3:12 But the law is not of faith, rather “The one who does them shall live by them.”

Galatians 3:13 **Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us**—for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree”—

Judges

Judges 21:25 In those days there was **no king** in Israel. **Everyone did what was right in his own eyes**.

1Samuel 8:5 and said to him, “Behold, you are old and your sons do not walk in your ways. Now appoint for us a **king** to judge us **like all the nations**.”

Revelation 19:16 On his robe and on his thigh he has a name written, **King of kings and Lord of lords**.

Ruth

Ruth 4:14 Then the women said to Naomi, “**Blessed be the LORD, who has not left you this day without a redeemer**, and may his name be renowned in Israel! Matthew 1:5 and Salmon the father of **Boaz by Rahab**, and Boaz the father of Obed **by Ruth**, and Obed the father of Jesse...

Matthew 1:6 and Jesse the father of **David the king**.

Galatians 3:29 And **if you are Christ’s, then you are Abraham’s offspring, heirs according to promise**.

1 Samuel

1Samuel 17:8 He stood and shouted to the ranks of Israel, “Why have you come out to draw up for battle? Am I not a Philistine, and are you not servants of Saul? **Choose a man for yourselves**, and let him come down to me.

1Samuel 17:9 **If he is able to fight with me and kill me, then we will be your servants. But if I prevail against him and kill him, then you shall be our servants and serve us.**”

1Corinthians 15:57 But thanks be to God, who gives us the **victory through our Lord Jesus Christ**.

1Corinthians 15:22 For as **in Adam** all die, so also **in Christ** shall all be made alive.

1 Kings

1Kings 18:37 Answer me, O LORD, answer me, **that this people may know that you, O LORD, are God**, and that **you have turned their hearts back.**”

1Kings 18:38 Then the **fire of the LORD fell and consumed** the burnt offering and the wood and the stones and the dust, and licked up the water that was in the trench.

John 3:36 Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the **wrath of God remains on him**.

2 Chronicles

2Chronicles 20:12 O our God, will you not execute judgment on them? **For we are powerless** against this great horde that is coming against us. **We do not know what to do, but our eyes are on you.**”

2Chronicles 20:15 And he said, “Listen, all Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem and King Jehoshaphat: Thus says the LORD to you, ‘**Do not be afraid and do not be dismayed** at this great horde, **for the battle is not yours but God’s.**”

Psalms

Psalms 22:1 My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?

Psalms 22:18 they divide my garments among them, and for my clothing they cast lots.

Psalms 118:22 The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone.

Psalms 110:4 The LORD has sworn and will not change his mind, **“You are a priest forever after the order of Melchizedek.”**

Isaiah

Isaiah 7:14 Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign. **Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.**

Isaiah 9:6 For to us a **child is born**, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called **Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.**

Isaiah 53:3 He was **despised and rejected by men**; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief; and as one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and **we esteemed him not.**

Isaiah 53:5 **But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities;** upon him was **the chastisement that brought us peace,** and **with his wounds we are healed.**

Isaiah 53:6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the **LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.**

Jeremiah

Jeremiah 23:5 “Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will raise up for David **a righteous Branch**, and **he shall reign as king** and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land.

Jeremiah 31:31 “Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will make a **new covenant** with the house of Israel and the house of Judah,

Jeremiah 31:32 **not like the covenant that I made with their fathers on the day when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt**, my covenant that they broke, though I was their husband, declares the LORD.

Jeremiah 31:33 For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the LORD: **I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people.**

Jeremiah 31:34 And no longer shall each one teach his neighbor and each his brother, saying, ‘Know the LORD,’ for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest, declares the LORD. **For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.”**

1Corinthians 11:25 In the same way also he took the cup, after supper, saying, “This cup is the **new covenant in my blood...**

Ezekiel

Ezekiel 34:23 And **I will set up over them one shepherd, my servant David, and he shall feed them: he shall feed them and be their shepherd.**

Ezekiel 34:24 And **I, the LORD, will be their God, and my servant David shall be prince among them. I am the LORD; I have spoken.**

Daniel

Daniel 7:13 “I saw in the night visions, and behold, with the clouds of heaven there came **one like a son of man**, and **he came to the Ancient of Days** and was presented before him.

Daniel 7:14 And to **him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom**, that **all peoples, nations, and languages should serve him; his dominion is an everlasting dominion**, which **shall not pass away**, and his kingdom one that shall not be destroyed.

Mark 14:61 But he remained silent and made no answer. Again the high priest asked him, “**Are you the Christ, the Son of the Blessed?**”

Mark 14:62 And Jesus said, “**I am, and you will see the Son of Man seated at the right hand of Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven.**”

Mark 14:63 And the high priest tore his garments and said, “What further witnesses do we need?”

Mark 14:64 **You have heard his blasphemy. What is your decision?**”**And they all condemned him as deserving death.**

Hosea

Hosea 3:1 And the LORD said to me, “Go again, love a woman who is loved by another man and is an adulteress, **even as the LORD loves the children of Israel, though they turn to other gods** and love cakes of raisins.”

Amos

Amos 8:9 “And on that day,” declares the Lord GOD, “**I will make the sun go down at noon and darken the earth in broad daylight.**”

Matthew 27:45 **Now from the sixth hour (noon) there was darkness over all the land** until the ninth hour.

Micah

Micah 5:2 But you, O **Bethlehem** Ephrathah, who are too little to be among the clans of Judah, **from you shall come forth for me one who is to be ruler in Israel, whose coming forth is from of old, from ancient days.**

Matthew 2:1 Now after **Jesus was born in Bethlehem** of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, wise men from the east came to Jerusalem,

Matthew 2:3 When Herod the king heard this, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him;

Matthew 2:4 and assembling all the chief priests and scribes of the people, **he inquired of them where the Christ was to be born.**

Matthew 2:5 They told him, “**In Bethlehem of Judea, for so it is written by the prophet:**

Haggai

Haggai 2:9 The **latter glory of this house shall be greater than the former**, says the LORD of hosts. And **in this place I will give peace**, declares the LORD of hosts.’”

Zechariah

Zechariah 6:12 And say to him, ‘Thus says the LORD of hosts, “**Behold, the man whose name is the Branch**: for he shall branch out from his place, and **he shall build the temple of the LORD**.”

Zechariah 6:13 It is he who shall build the temple of the LORD and shall bear royal honor, and **shall sit and rule on his throne**. And **there shall be a priest on his throne**, and the counsel of peace shall be between them both.”

Zechariah 9:9 Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout aloud, O daughter of Jerusalem! **Behold, your king is coming to you; righteous and having salvation is he, humble and mounted on a donkey**, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

Zechariah 12:10 “And I will pour out on the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem a **spirit of grace and pleas for mercy**, so that, **when they look on me, on him whom they have pierced, they shall mourn for him**, as one mourns for an only child, and weep bitterly over him, as one weeps over a firstborn.

Malachi

Malachi 3:1 “**Behold, I send my messenger, and he will prepare the way before me**. And the **Lord whom you seek will suddenly come to his temple**; and the messenger of the covenant in whom you delight, behold, **he is coming**, says the LORD of hosts.

Luke 2:10 And the angel said to them, “**Fear not**, for behold, I bring you **good news of great joy** that will be for all the people.

Luke 2:11 For **unto you is born** this day in the city of David **a Savior, who is Christ the Lord**.

Mark 8:31 And he began to teach them that the **Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected** by the elders and the chief priests and the scribes and **be killed, and after three days rise again**.

John 19:30 When Jesus had received the sour wine, he said, “**It is finished**,” and he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.

Revelation 22:3 **No longer will there be anything accursed**, but the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in it, and **his servants will worship him**.
