Romans 3:1-2 • The Oracles Of God

Romans 3:1 **Then what advantage has the Jew?** Or what is the value of circumcision?

Romans 3:2 Much in every way. **To begin** with, the Jews were **entrusted** with the **oracles of God.**

Matthew 6:33 But seek **first** the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.

Romans 1:8 **First,** I thank my God through Jesus Christ for all of you, because your faith is proclaimed in all the world.

Romans 3:2 Much every way: **chiefly**, because that unto them were committed the **oracles of God.**

2Timothy 3:16 **All Scripture is breathed out by God** and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness,

Hebrews 4:12 For the **word of God is living and active,** sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

Deuteronomy 8:3 And he humbled you and let you hunger and fed you with manna, which you did not know, nor did your fathers know, that he might make you know that man does not live by bread alone, but **man lives by every word that comes from the mouth of the LORD.**

Amos 8:11 "Behold, the days are coming," declares the Lord GOD, "when I will send a famine on the land— not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, **but of hearing the words of the LORD.**

John 5:46 For if you believed Moses, you would believe me; for he wrote of me.

Luke 24:27 And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the **things concerning himself.**

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

Romans 1:17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith, **as it is written**, "The righteous shall live by faith."

Luke 22:37 For I tell you that this **Scripture must be fulfilled in me**: 'And he was numbered with the transgressors.' For what is written about me has its fulfillment."

Matthew 1:22 All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophet:

Matthew 5:17 "Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; **I** have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them.

Luke 4:16 And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up. And as was his custom, he went to the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and he stood up to read.

Luke 4:17 And the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was given to him. He unrolled the scroll and found the place where it was written,

Luke 4:18 "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed,

Luke 4:19 to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor."

Luke 4:20 And he rolled up the scroll and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all in the synagogue were fixed on him.

Luke 4:21 And he began to say to them, **"Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing."**

1Samuel 3:21 And the LORD appeared again at Shiloh, for **the LORD revealed himself to Samuel at Shiloh by the word of the LORD.**

Ephesians 2:1 And you were dead in the trespasses and sins

Ephesians 2:4 **But God**, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us,

Ephesians 2:5 even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved—

1Corinthians 2:14 The **natural person does not accept the things of the Spirit** of God, for they are folly to him, and **he is not able to understand them because they are spiritually discerned.**

1Peter 1:23 since **you have been born again**, not of perishable seed but of imperishable, **through the living and abiding word of God**;

1Peter 1:24 for "All flesh is like grass and all its glory like the flower of grass. The grass withers, and the flower falls,

1Peter 1:25 but the word of the Lord remains forever." And this word is the good news that was preached to you.

James 1:18 Of his own will **he brought us forth by the word of truth**, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures.

2Corinthians 4:6 For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

Romans 10:17 So **faith comes from hearing**, and **hearing through the word of Christ.**

John 6:35 Jesus said to them, "I am the **bread of life**; whoever comes to me shall not **hunger**, and **whoever believes in me** shall never **thirst**.

John 7:37 On the last day of the feast, the great day, Jesus stood up and cried out, **"If anyone thirsts, let him come to me and drink.**

John 7:38 Whoever **believes in me**, as the Scripture has said, 'Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.'"

Matthew 6:21 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Psalms 16:11 You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

Matthew 15:8 "This people honors me with their lips, but **their heart is far from** me;

Matthew 15:9 in **vain do they worship me**, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men."

Philippians 1:6 And I am sure of this, that **he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ.**

Psalms 119:36 Incline my heart to your testimonies, and not to selfish gain!

John 20:31 but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

John 17:17 Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth.

John 8:32 and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

2Peter 1:4 by which he has granted to us **his precious and very great promises**, so that **through them** you may become partakers of the divine nature, having **escaped from the corruption that is in the world because of sinful desire.**

Ephesians 3:14 For this reason I bow my knees before the Father,

Ephesians 3:15 from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named,

Ephesians 3:16 that according to the riches of his glory **he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being**,

Ephesians 3:17 so that **Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith**—that you, being rooted and grounded in love,

Ephesians 3:18 may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth,

Ephesians 3:19 and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.
