

**Romans 2:11-29 • God Shows No Partiality
&
The Importance Of Being Truly Jewish**

Romans 2:11 For **God shows no partiality.**

Romans 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the **gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes,** to the **Jew** first and also to the **Greek.**

Romans 1:17 For in it the **righteousness of God** is revealed from faith for faith, as it is written, “**The righteous shall live by faith.**”

Romans 1:18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, **who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth.**

Romans 1:19 For **what can be known about God is plain to them,** because **God has shown it to them.**

Job 42:2 “I know that you can do all things, and that **no purpose of yours can be thwarted.**

Romans 1:20 For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. **So they are without excuse.**

Romans 1:32 Though **they know God’s righteous decree that those who practice such things deserve to die,** they not only do them but give approval to those who practice them.

Romans 3:10 as it is written: “**None is righteous, no, not one;**

Romans 3:11 **no one understands; no one seeks for God.**

Romans 3:12 **All have turned aside;** together they have become worthless; **no one does good, not even one.”**

Romans 3:20 For **by works of the law no human being will be justified in his sight,** since **through the law comes knowledge of sin.**

Romans 3:23 for **all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,**

Romans 3:28 For we hold that one is **justified by faith apart from works of the law.**

Location, Location, Location...

Romans 2:12 For **all who have sinned without the law will also perish without the law, and all who have sinned under the law will be judged by the law.**

Romans 2:13 For it is not the **hearers of the law who are righteous before God, but the doers of the law who will be justified.**

Galatians 4:4 But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, **born under the law,**

Matthew 5:17 “Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; **I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them.**

Romans 2:14 For when **Gentiles, who do not have the law,** by nature do what the law requires, they are a law to themselves, **even though they do not have the law.**

Romans 2:15 They show that the **work of the law is written on their hearts,** while their **conscience also bears witness,** and their **conflicting thoughts accuse or even excuse them**

“the work of the law”

“through the law comes knowledge of sin.”

“they know God’s righteous decree

that those who practice such things deserve to die”

Romans 2:16 on **that day** when, **according to my gospel, God judges the secrets of men by Christ Jesus.**

Romans 2:17 But if you **call yourself a Jew** and **rely on the law** and **boast in God**

Romans 2:18 and **know his will** and **approve what is excellent,** because you are **instructed from the law;**

Romans 2:19 and **if you are sure** that you yourself are a **guide to the blind,** a **light to those who are in darkness,**

Romans 2:20 an **instructor of the foolish**, a **teacher of children**, having in the law the embodiment of knowledge and truth—

Romans 2:21 you then who teach others, **do you not teach yourself?** While you preach against stealing, **do you steal?**

Romans 2:22 You who say that one must not commit adultery, **do you commit adultery?** You who abhor idols, **do you rob temples?**

Deuteronomy 7:25 The carved images of their gods you shall burn with fire. **You shall not covet the silver or the gold that is on them or take it for yourselves**, lest you be ensnared by it, for it is an abomination to the LORD your God.

Romans 2:23 **You who boast in the law dishonor God by breaking the law.**

Romans 2:24 For, as it is written, **“The name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles because of you.”**

Ezekiel 36:20 But when they came to the nations, wherever they came, **they profaned my holy name, in that people said of them, ‘These are the people of the LORD, and yet they had to go out of his land.’**

Ezekiel 36:21 But **I had concern for my holy name**, which the house of Israel had **profaned** among the nations to which they came.

Ezekiel 36:22 “Therefore say to the house of Israel, Thus says the Lord GOD: It is not for your sake, O house of Israel, that I am about to act, but for the sake of my holy name, which you have **profaned** among the nations to which you came.

Ezekiel 36:23 And I will vindicate the holiness of my great name, which has been **profaned** among the nations, and which you have **profaned** among them. **And the nations will know that I am the LORD**, declares the Lord GOD, **when through you I vindicate my holiness before their eyes.**

Ezekiel 36:24 I will take you from the nations and gather you from all the countries and bring you into your own land.

Ezekiel 36:25 I will **sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean from all your uncleannesses**, and from all your idols I will cleanse you.

Ezekiel 36:26 And **I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you.** And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.

Ezekiel 36:27 And **I will put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to obey my rules.**

Ezekiel 36:28 You shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers, and **you shall be my people, and I will be your God.**

Romans 2:25 For circumcision indeed is of value **if you obey the law**, but if you break the law, your circumcision becomes uncircumcision.

Romans 4:11 He received the sign of circumcision as **a seal of the righteousness that he had by faith while he was still uncircumcised.** The purpose was to make him the father of all who believe without being circumcised, so that righteousness would be counted to them as well,

James 2:10 For whoever keeps the whole law **but fails in one point has become accountable for all of it.**

Romans 2:26 So, if a man who is **uncircumcised** keeps the precepts of the law, will **not his uncircumcision be regarded as circumcision?**

Romans 2:27 Then he who is **physically uncircumcised** but keeps the law will condemn **you who have the written code and circumcision but break the law.**

Romans 2:28 For **no one is a Jew who is merely one outwardly, nor is circumcision outward and physical.**

Romans 2:29 But a **Jew is one inwardly, and circumcision is a matter of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the letter. His praise is not from man but from God.**

Colossians 2:11 In him also you were circumcised with a circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of the flesh, **by the circumcision of Christ,**

1Corinthians 7:19 For neither circumcision counts for anything nor uncircumcision, **but keeping the commandments of God.**

Galatians 5:6 For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision counts for anything, **but only faith working through love.**

John 14:21 Whoever **has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves me.** And he who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and manifest myself to him.”

Romans 10:4 For **Christ is the end of the law for righteousness** to everyone who believes.

Galatians 2:21 I do not nullify the grace of God, **for if righteousness were through the law, then Christ died for no purpose.**

Philippians 3:9 and be found in him, **not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law,** but that which comes through faith in Christ, **the righteousness from God that depends on faith—**

Jeremiah 31:33 For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the LORD: **I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts.** And I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

Hebrews 8:10 For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the Lord: **I will put my laws into their minds, and write them on their hearts,** and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

Romans 7:6 But now we are released from the law, having died to that which held us captive, so that **we serve in the new way of the Spirit and not in the old way of the written code.**

Psalms 40:8 I delight to do your will, O my God; your law is within my heart.”
