## Romans 8:28-30 • Security From Eternity Past

1John 2:19 They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would have continued with us. But they went out, that it might become plain that they all are not of us.

Romans 8:28 And we know that **for those who love God** all things work together for good, **for those who are called** according to **his purpose**.

Romans 8:29 For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers.

Romans 8:30 And **those** whom he **predestined** he also **called**, and **those** whom he called he also **justified**, and **those** whom he **justified** he also **glorified**.

## Foreknew - Predestined Called Justified - Glorified

All people that are glorified have been justified. All people that are justified have been called. All people that are called have been predestined. All people that are predestined have been foreknown.

Foresee vs Foreknow Justification is by faith, which is a gift. Faith is not a self determined faith. General Call vs Effectual Call

1Peter 1:20 He (Jesus) was **foreknown** before the **foundation of the world** but was made manifest in the last times for the sake of you

1Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.

Romans 3:21 But now the **righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law**, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it—

Romans 3:22 the righteousness of God **through faith** in Jesus Christ for **all who believe**. For there is no distinction:

Romans 3:24 and are **justified** by his grace **as a gift**, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus...

Romans 3:26 It was to show his righteousness at the present time, so that **he might be just** and **the justifier** of the **one who has faith in Jesus**.

Romans 3:27 Then what becomes of our boasting? It is excluded. By what kind of law? By a law of works? No, but by the law of faith.

Romans 3:28 For we hold that one is **justified by faith** apart from works of the law.

Ephesians 2:8 For by grace you have been **saved through faith.** And this is not your own doing; **it is the gift of God**,

1Corinthians 2:9 But, as it is written, "What no eye has seen, nor ear heard, nor the heart of man imagined, what God has prepared for those who love him"—

1Corinthians 2:10 these things **God has revealed to us through the Spirit**. For the Spirit searches everything, even the depths of God.

1Corinthians 2:12 Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might understand the things freely given us by God.

1Corinthians 2:13 And we impart this in words not taught by human wisdom but taught by the Spirit, interpreting spiritual truths to those who are spiritual.

1Corinthians 2:14 The natural person does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are spiritually discerned.

1Thessalonians 1:5 because our gospel came to you **not only in word**, but **also in power and in the Holy Spirit** and **with full conviction.** You know what kind of men we proved to be among you for your sake.

Romans 8:7 For the mind that is set on the flesh is **hostile to God**, for it does not submit to God's law; **indeed**, **it cannot**.

John 3:19 And this is the judgment: the **light has come** into the world, and **people loved the darkness rather than the light** because their works were evil.

John 3:20 For everyone who does wicked things **hates the light** and **does not come to the light**, lest his works should be exposed.

Romans 3:10 as it is written: "None is righteous, no, not one;

Romans 3:11 no one understands; no one seeks for God.

John 3:3 Jesus answered him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, **unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God.**"

John 3:6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is **born of the Spirit is spirit.** 

John 3:7 Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be born again.'

2Corinthians 4:3 And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing.

2Corinthians 4:4 In their case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, to keep them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

Ephesians 2:1 And you were dead in the trespasses and sins

Ephesians 2:2 in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience—

Ephesians 2:3 among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind.

Mark 3:27 But no one can enter a strong man's house and plunder his goods, **unless** he first binds the strong man. Then indeed he may plunder his house.

Ephesians 5:14 for anything that **becomes visible** is light. Therefore it says, "Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you."

John 6:44 **No one can come to me unless** the Father who sent me **draws him**. And I will raise him up on the last day.

John 8:46 Which one of you convicts me of sin? If I tell the truth, **why do you not** believe me?

John 8:47 Whoever is of God hears the words of God. The reason why you do not hear them is that you are not of God."

John 10:25 Jesus answered them, "I told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in my Father's name bear witness about me,

John 10:26 but you do not believe because you are not among my sheep.

John 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me.

Acts 13:48 And when the Gentiles heard this, they began rejoicing and glorifying the word of the Lord, **and as many as were appointed to eternal life believed.** 

Acts 16:14 One **who heard** us was a woman named Lydia, from the city of Thyatira, a seller of purple goods, who was a worshiper of God. **The Lord opened her heart to pay attention to what was said by Paul.** 

Acts 11:18 When they heard these things they fell silent. And they glorified God, saying, "Then to the Gentiles also **God has granted repentance that leads to life.**"

2Timothy 2:24 And the Lord's servant must not be quarrelsome but kind to everyone, able to teach, patiently enduring evil,

2Timothy 2:25 correcting his opponents with gentleness. God may perhaps grant them repentance leading to a knowledge of the truth,

2Timothy 2:26 and **they may come to their senses and escape from the snare of the devil**, after being captured by him to do his will.

2Timothy 1:9 who saved us and called us to a holy calling, not because of our works but because of his own purpose and grace, which he gave us in Christ Jesus before the ages began,

Acts 9:1 But Saul, still breathing threats and murder against the disciples of the Lord, went to the high priest

Acts 9:2 and asked him for letters to the synagogues at Damascus, so that if he found **any belonging to the Way, men or women, he might bring them bound to Jerusalem.** 

Acts 9:3 Now as he went on his way, he approached Damascus, and suddenly a light from heaven shone around him.

Acts 9:4 And falling to the ground he heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?"

Acts 9:5 And he said, "Who are you, Lord?" And he said, "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting.

Acts 26:9 "I myself was convinced that I ought to do many things in opposing the name of Jesus of Nazareth.

Acts 26:10 And I did so in Jerusalem. I not only locked up many of the saints in prison after receiving authority from the chief priests, but when they were put to death I cast my vote against them.

Acts 26:11 And I punished them often in all the synagogues and tried to make them blaspheme, and in raging fury against them I persecuted them even to foreign cities.

Acts 26:12 "In this connection I journeyed to Damascus with the authority and commission of the chief priests.

Acts 26:13 At midday, O king, **I saw on the way a light from heaven**, brighter than the sun, that shone around me and those who journeyed with me.

Acts 26:14 And when we had all fallen to the ground, **I heard a voice saying to me in the Hebrew language**, 'Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me? It is hard for you to kick against the goads.'

Acts 26:15 And I said, 'Who are you, Lord?' And the Lord said, 'I am Jesus whom you are persecuting.

Acts 26:16 But rise and stand upon your feet, for **I have appeared to you for this purpose, to appoint you** as a servant and witness to the things in which you have seen me and to those in which I will appear to you,

Acts 26:17 delivering you from your people and from the Gentiles— to whom I am sending you

Acts 26:18 to open their eyes, so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me.'

Acts 26:19 "Therefore, O King Agrippa, I was not disobedient to the heavenly vision,

1Corinthians 1:26 For **consider your calling**, brothers: not many of you were wise according to worldly standards, not many were powerful, not many were of noble birth.

1Corinthians 1:27 But **God chose** what is foolish in the world to shame the wise; God chose what is weak in the world to shame the strong;

1Corinthians 1:28 **God chose** what is low and despised in the world, even things that are not, to bring to nothing things that are,

1Corinthians 1:29 so that no human being might boast in the presence of God.

1Corinthians 1:30 And **because of him you are in Christ Jesus**, who became to us wisdom from God, righteousness and sanctification and redemption,

Ezekiel 37:3 And he said to me, "**Son of man, can these bones live**?" And I answered, "**O Lord God, you know.**"

Ezekiel 37:5 Thus says the Lord God to these bones: Behold, I will cause breath to enter you, and you shall live.
