Romans 8:14 • Led By The Spirit

Romans 8:33 Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who **justifies**.

Romans 5:19 For as by the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, so by the **one man's obedience** the many will be made **righteous**.

Colossians 1:22 he has now reconciled in his body of flesh by his death, in order to present you **holy** and **blameless** and **above reproach before him**,

Romans 6:4 We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life.

Romans 6:6 We know that our old self was crucified with him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin.

Romans 6:11 So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus.

Romans 6:17 But **thanks be to God**, that you who were once slaves of sin have become **obedient from the heart** to the standard of teaching to which you were committed,

Romans 6:22 But now that **you have been set free from sin** and have become slaves of God, the **fruit you get leads to sanctification and its end, eternal life**.

Romans 7:6 But **now we are released from the law**, having died to that which held us captive, so that **we serve in the new way of the Spirit and not in the old way of the written code.**

Romans 7:15 For **I do not understand my** own **actions.** For I do not do what I want, but I do the very thing I hate.

Romans 7:18 For I know that **nothing good dwells in me, that is, in my flesh**. For I have the desire to do what is right, but not the ability to carry it out. Romans 7:22 For I delight in the law of God, in my inner being,

Romans 7:23 but I see in my **members** another law **waging war** against the **law of my mind** and making me captive to the law of **sin that dwells in my members**.

Romans 7:24 Wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death?

I do not want to sin.

I have the desire to do what is right.

I delight in the law of God in my inner being.

I do not have the ability to do what I want.

Who will deliver me from this body, so I can actually do what I want? Who will supply the ability to match my desire?

Romans 7:25 Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, I myself serve the law of God with my mind, but with my flesh I serve the law of sin.

There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death. For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do. By sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, he condemned sin in the flesh, in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

You, however, are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him. But if Christ is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, the Spirit is life because of righteousness. If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the

dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you.

So then, brothers, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh. For if you live according to the flesh you will die, but if (you live) by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live.

The righteous requirements of the law, which I delight in, I can now fulfill by the Spirit.

The Spirit leads me to do what I desire and put to death the deeds of the body that I do not want to do, proving that I am a son of God.

For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God.

Galatians 3:26 for in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God, through faith.

Luke 4:1 And Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was **led** by the Spirit in the wilderness

1Corinthians 12:2 You know that **when you were pagans** you were **led** astray to mute idols, **however you were led**.

John 10:16 And I have other sheep that are not of this fold. I must **bring** them also, and **they will listen to my voice**. So there will be one flock, one shepherd.

John 10:27 My sheep **hear my voice**, and I know them, and they follow me.

1Corinthians 2:10 these things **God has revealed to us through the Spirit**. For the Spirit searches everything, even the depths of God.

1Corinthians 2:12 Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might understand the things freely given us by God.

1Corinthians 2:14 The natural person does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are spiritually discerned.

John 8:44 You are of your father the devil, and your will is to do your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks out of his own character, for he is a liar and the father of lies.

Ephesians 2:1 And you were dead in the trespasses and sins

Ephesians 2:2 in which you once walked, **following the course of this world**, **following the prince of the power of the air**, the spirit that is now at work in the **sons of disobedience**—

Ephesians 2:3 among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind.

Ephesians 2:4 But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us,

Ephesians 2:5 even when we were dead in our trespasses, **made us alive together** with Christ—by grace you have been saved—

John 14:17 even the **Spirit of truth**, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. **You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you.**

John 16:13 When the **Spirit of truth** comes, **he will guide you into all the truth**, for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come.

Galatians 5:16 But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh.

You, however, are not in the flesh but in the Spirit

Galatians 5:17 For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the **desires of** the Spirit are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do.

Galatians 5:18 But if you are **led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.**

For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God.
