

Romans 11

Two Covenants Or One Covenant? Israel And The Church

Romans 11:1a I ask, then, **has God rejected his people?** By no means!

Romans 11:12 Now if their (ethnic Israel) trespass means riches for the world, and if their (ethnic Israel) failure means riches for the Gentiles, **how much more will their (ethnic Israel) full inclusion mean!**

Romans 11:25 Lest you be wise in your own sight, I do not want you to be unaware of this **mystery**, brothers: a **partial hardening** has come upon **Israel** (ethnic Israel), until the **fullness of the Gentiles has come in.**

Romans 11:26 And in this way **all Israel** (ethnic Israel) **will be saved**, as it is written, “The Deliverer will come from Zion, he will banish ungodliness from Jacob”;

1. All Israel will be saved means:
2. All Spiritual Israel will be saved.
3. All Jews who ever lived at any time will be saved, even though they rejected Jesus as Messiah, simply because they are God’s chosen people.
4. All living Jews at the return of Christ will believe and be saved.
5. All, means a revival within Israel where a majority of Jews will be saved.

Acts 17:11 Now these **Jews** were more noble than those in Thessalonica; they **received the word** with all eagerness, **examining the Scriptures daily to see if these things were so.**

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning, God
The Bible which is the word of **God is without error.**

2Timothy 3:16 All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness,

2Timothy 3:17 that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

2Peter 1:21 For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were **carried along** by the Holy Spirit.

Romans 9:6 But **it is not as though the word of God has failed**. For **not all** who are **descended from Israel belong to Israel**,

Romans 9:7 and **not all are children of Abraham** because they are his offspring, but “Through Isaac shall your offspring be named.”

Romans 9:8 **This means that it is not the children of the flesh who are the children of God, but the children of the promise are counted as offspring.**

Romans 10:12 For there is **no distinction** between **Jew and Greek**; for the same Lord is Lord of all, bestowing his riches **on all who call on him**.

Romans 2:28 For **no one is a Jew who is merely one outwardly**, nor is circumcision outward and physical.

Romans 2:29 **But a Jew is one inwardly, and circumcision is a matter of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the letter**. His praise is not from man but from God.

Romans 10:13 For “**everyone** who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”

Romans 11:2a **God has not rejected his people whom he foreknew**.

Romans 11:5 So too at the present time there is a **remnant, chosen by grace**.

Romans 11:6 But if it is by grace, it is no longer on the basis of works; otherwise grace would no longer be grace.

Romans 11:7 What then? Israel failed to obtain what it was seeking. **The elect obtained it, but the rest were hardened**,

Acts 16:31 And they said, “Believe in the Lord Jesus, and **you will be saved**, you and your household.”

John 1:12 But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become **children of God**,

1Peter 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, **he has caused us to be born again** to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

Romans 9:27 And Isaiah cries out concerning Israel: "Though the number of the sons of Israel be as the sand of the sea, **only a remnant of them will be saved,**

Romans 11:13 Now I am speaking to you Gentiles. Inasmuch then as I am an apostle to the Gentiles, I magnify my ministry

Romans 11:14 in order somehow to make **my fellow Jews** jealous, and thus **save some of them.**

Acts 4:10 let it be known to all of you and to **all the people of Israel** that **by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth**, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead—by him this man is standing before you well.

Acts 4:11 This **Jesus is the stone that was rejected by you**, the builders, which has become the cornerstone.

Acts 4:12 And **there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."**

Acts 13:46 And Paul and Barnabas spoke out boldly, saying, "It was necessary that the word of God be spoken first to you. **Since you thrust it aside and judge yourselves unworthy of eternal life, behold, we are turning to the Gentiles.**

Matthew 21:43 Therefore I tell you, the **kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people producing its fruits.**

Matthew 8:11 I tell you, many will come from east and west and recline at table with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven,

Matthew 8:12 **while the sons of the kingdom will be thrown into the outer darkness.** In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.”

Luke 21:24 They will fall by the edge of the sword and be led captive among all nations, and Jerusalem will be trampled underfoot by the Gentiles, **until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled.**

John 8:13 So the **Pharisees** said to him, “You are bearing witness about yourself; your testimony is not true.”

John 8:18 I am the one who bears witness about myself, and the **Father who sent me bears witness about me.**”

John 8:19 They said to him therefore, “Where is your Father?” Jesus answered, **“You know neither me nor my Father. If you knew me, you would know my Father also.”**

John 8:21 So he said to them again, “I am going away, and you will seek me, and **you will die in your sin. Where I am going, you cannot come.**”

John 8:23 He said to them, **“You are from below; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world.**

John 8:24 **I told you that you would die in your sins, for unless you believe that I am he you will die in your sins.”**

John 8:37 **I know that you are offspring of Abraham;** yet you seek to kill me because my word finds no place in you.

John 8:38 I speak of what I have seen with my Father, and you do what you have heard from your father.”

John 8:39 They answered him, **“Abraham is our father.”** Jesus said to them, **“If you were Abraham’s children, you would be doing the works Abraham did,**

John 8:40 but now you seek to kill me, a man who has **told you the truth that I heard from God. This is not what Abraham did.**

John 8:41 **You are doing the works your father did.**” They said to him, “We were not born of sexual immorality. We have one Father—even God.”

John 8:42 Jesus said to them, “**If God were your Father, you would love me,** for I came from God and I am here. I came not of my own accord, but he sent me.

John 8:43 Why do you not understand what I say? **It is because you cannot bear to hear my word.**

John 8:44 **You are of your father the devil, and your will is to do your father’s desires.** He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks out of his own character, for he is a liar and the father of lies.

John 8:45 But because **I tell the truth, you do not believe me.**

John 8:57 So the Jews said to him, “You are not yet fifty years old, and have you seen Abraham?”

John 8:58 Jesus said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was, **I am.**”

John 8:59 So **they picked up stones to throw at him,** but Jesus hid himself and went out of the temple.

John 10:24 So **the Jews gathered around him** and said to him, “How long will you keep us in suspense? **If you are the Christ, tell us plainly.**”

John 10:25 Jesus answered them, “**I told you, and you do not believe.** The works that I do in my Father’s name bear witness about me,

John 10:26 but **you do not believe because you are not among my sheep.**

John 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me.

John 10:28 **I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand.**

John 10:29 My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all, and **no one is able to snatch them out of the Father’s hand.**

John 10:30 I and the Father are one.”

John 10:31 **The Jews picked up stones again to stone him.**

Romans 11:6 But if it is by grace, **it is no longer on the basis of works**; otherwise grace would no longer be grace.

Ephesians 1:3 ¶ Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places,

Ephesians 1:4 even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him. In love

Ephesians 1:5 he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will,

Ephesians 1:6 to the praise of his glorious grace, with which he has blessed us in the Beloved.
