Luke 16:19-31 • 'They Have Moses and the Prophets; Let Them Hear them'

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

John 1:12 But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God,

John 3:7 Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be born again.'

John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

1Peter 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his **great mercy**, **he has caused us to be born again** to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

1Peter 1:4 to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you,

1Peter 1:5 who by **God's power are being guarded through faith** for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

Ephesians 2:8 For by grace you have been **saved through faith**. And this is not your own doing; **it is the gift of God**,

Ephesians 2:9 not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

Galatians 2:16 yet we know that a person is not justified by **works of the law** but through faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ and not by **works of the law**, because by **works of the law** no one will be justified.

1Peter 1:6 In this you rejoice, though now for a little while, **if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials**,

1Peter 1:7 so that the **tested genuineness of your faith**—more precious than gold that perishes **though it is tested by fire**—**may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ.**

Luke 8:4 And when a great crowd was gathering and people from town after town came to him, **he said in a parable**,

Luke 8:5 "A sower went out to sow his seed. And as he sowed, some fell along the path and was trampled underfoot, and the birds of the air devoured it.

Luke 8:6 And some fell on the rock, and as it grew up, it withered away, because it had no moisture.

Luke 8:7 And some fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up with it and choked it.

Luke 8:8 And some fell into good soil and grew and yielded a hundredfold." As he said these things, he called out, **"He who has ears to hear, let him hear."**

Luke 8:9 And when his disciples asked him what this parable meant,

Luke 8:10 he said, "To you it has been given to know the secrets of the kingdom of God, but for others they are in parables, so that 'seeing they may not see, and hearing they may not understand.'

Luke 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God.

Romans 10:17 So **faith** comes from **hearing**, and **hearing** through the **word of Christ.**

Luke 8:12 The ones along the path are those who have **heard**; then the devil comes and **takes away the word from their hearts**, so that they may **not believe and be saved.**

Luke 8:13 And the ones on the rock are those who, when they **hear the word**, **receive it with joy**. But these have **no root; they believe for a while, and in time of testing fall away.** (tested genuineness of your faith)

Luke 8:14 And as for what fell among the thorns, they are those who **hear**, but as they go on their way they are **choked by the cares** and **riches** and **pleasures of life**, and **their fruit does not mature**.

1John 2:19 They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would have continued with us. But they went out, that it might become plain that they all are not of us.

1John 2:20 But **you have been anointed by the Holy One**, and you all have knowledge.

Ephesians 1:13 In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit,

Ephesians 1:14 who is the **guarantee of our inheritance** until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory.

Galatians 3:2 Let me ask you only this: Did you receive the Spirit by works of the law or by hearing with faith?

1Peter 1:4 to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you,

Luke 8:15 As for that in the **good soil**, they are those who, **hearing the word**, **hold it fast in an honest and good heart**, and **bear fruit with patience**. 2Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.

Luke 16:13 No servant can serve two masters, for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and money."

Luke 16:14 The **Pharisees**, who were **lovers of money**, heard all these things, and **they ridiculed him**.

Luke 16:15 And he said to them, "You are those who justify yourselves before men, but God knows your hearts. For what is exalted among men is an abomination in the sight of God.

Luke 16:19 "There was a **rich man** who was **clothed in purple** and **fine linen** and who **feasted sumptuously every day.**

Luke 16:20 And at his gate was laid a poor man named Lazarus, covered with sores,

Luke 16:21 who **desired to be fed** with **what fell from the rich man's table**. Moreover, **even the dogs came and licked his sores**.

Luke 16:22 The **poor man died** and was **carried by the angels to Abraham's side**. The **rich man also died** and was **buried**,

Luke 16:23 and **in Hades**, **being in torment**, he lifted up his eyes and saw **Abraham far off** and **Lazarus at his side**.

Luke 13:28 "There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth, for you will see Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and all the prophets in the Kingdom of God, but you will be thrown out.

Luke 13:29 And **people will come from all over the world**—from east and west, north and south—**to take their places in the Kingdom of God.**

Luke 16:24 And he called out, **'Father Abraham**, have mercy on me, and **send** Lazarus to dip the end of his finger in water and cool my tongue, for I am in anguish in this flame.'

Luke 3:8 Prove by the way you live that you have repented of your sins and turned to God. Don't just say to each other, 'We're safe, for we are descendants of Abraham.' That means nothing, for I tell you, God can create children of Abraham from these very stones.

Luke 16:25 But Abraham said, 'Child, **remember that you in your lifetime received your good things**, and **Lazarus in like manner bad things**; but now **he is comforted here**, and **you are in anguish**.

Genesis 24:35 "And the Lord has greatly blessed my master (Abraham); he has become a **wealthy man**. The Lord has given him flocks of sheep and goats, herds of cattle, **a fortune in silver and gold**, and many male and female servants and camels and donkeys.

1Timothy 6:7 After all, we brought nothing with us when we came into the world, and we can't take anything with us when we leave it.

1Timothy 6:8 So if we have enough food and clothing, let us be content.

1Timothy 6:9 But **people who long to be rich** fall into temptation and are **trapped** by many foolish and harmful desires **that plunge them into ruin and destruction**.

1Timothy 6:10 For the **love of money is the root of all kinds of evil**. And some people, **craving money, have wandered from the true faith** and **pierced themselves with many sorrows.**

Luke 8:14 And as for what fell among the thorns, they are those who **hear**, but as they go on their way they are **choked by the cares** and **riches** and **pleasures of life**, and **their fruit does not mature**.

Luke 16:13 No servant can serve two masters, for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and money."

Luke 16:26 And besides all this, **between us and you a great chasm has been fixed**, in order that those who would pass from here to you may not be able, and **none may cross from there to us.'**

Luke 16:27 And he said, 'Then I beg you, father, to send him to my father's house

Luke 16:28 for **I have five brothers**—so that he may **warn them, lest they also come into this place of torment.**'

Luke 16:29 But Abraham said, 'They have Moses and the Prophets; let them hear them.'

Luke 16:30 And he said, 'No, father Abraham, but **if someone goes to them from the dead, they will repent.'**

Luke 16:31 He said to him, 'If they do not hear Moses and the Prophets, neither will they be convinced if someone should rise from the dead.'"

John 11:43 When he had said these things, he cried out with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out."

John 11:44 The man who had died came out, his hands and feet bound with linen strips, and his face wrapped with a cloth. Jesus said to them, "Unbind him, and let him go."

John 11:45 Many of the Jews therefore, who had come with Mary and had seen what he did, believed in him,

John 11:46 but some of them went to the Pharisees and told them what Jesus had done.

John 11:47 So the chief priests and the Pharisees gathered the council and said, "What are we to do? For this man performs many signs.

John 11:48 If we let him go on like this, everyone will believe in him, and the Romans will come and take away both our place and our nation."

John 11:49 But one of them, Caiaphas, who was high priest that year, said to them, "You know nothing at all.

John 11:50 Nor do you understand that it is better for you that one man should die for the people, not that the whole nation should perish."

John 11:51 He did not say this of his own accord, but being high priest that year he prophesied that Jesus would die for the nation,

John 11:52 and not for the nation only, but also to gather into one the children of God who are scattered abroad.

John 11:53 So from that day on they made plans to put him to death.

'They have Moses and the Prophets; let them hear them.'

Psalms 14:1 The fool says in his heart, "There is no God." They are corrupt, they do abominable deeds; there is none who does good.

Psalms 14:2 The Lord looks down from heaven on the children of man, to see if there are any who understand, who seek after God.

Psalms 14:3 They have all turned aside; together they have become corrupt; there is none who does good, not even one.

Isaiah 53:4 Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted.

Isaiah 53:5 But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed.

Isaiah 53:6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

Isaiah 45:22 "Turn to me and be saved, all the ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other.

John 5:46 For if you believed Moses, you would believe me; for he wrote of me.
