

Ephesians 2:11-19 • Shalom

God's eternal purpose is to reveal His glorious grace to His adopted sons and daughters that results in them valuing Christ above everything and becoming the means of unity and love within His Body, the church.

*Dead / Alive / Grace / **Peace** / Blessed / Loved / Hope*

Numbers 6:23-26 “Speak to Aaron and his sons, saying, Thus you shall **ble**ss the people of Israel: you shall say to them, The **LORD bless you and keep you**; the **LORD make his face to shine upon you and be gracious to you**; the **LORD lift up his countenance upon you and give you peace** (*shalom*).

“Shalom/peace is not simply the absence of conflict it is the presence of something greater.”

“The root meaning of **shalom** is to be whole or sound and this leads to translations that speak of completeness, wholeness, well-being, welfare and peace. **Shalom** also includes the idea of vigour and vitality in all dimensions of life. In short, **shalom** speaks of holistic ("holy") health for our souls and spirits.”

“Shalom is a large, embracing word for the good that comes to the one God favors.”

Shalom: peace, well, whole, wholeness, uncut, favorable, just, restoration, restitution, reward, welfare, safe, safety, greet, health, finished, how are you **doing?**, How is it **going?**, prosperity, close friend, friends, well-being.

Psalms 122:6 Pray for the **peace** (*shalom*) of Jerusalem! “May they be secure who love you!

Psalms 122:7 **Peace** (*shalom*) **be within your walls** and **security** within your towers!”

Psalms 4:8 In **peace** (*shalom*) **I will both lie down and sleep**; for you alone, O LORD, **make me dwell in safety**.

Psalms 35:27 Let those who delight in **my righteousness** shout for **joy** and be **glad** and say evermore, “Great is the LORD, who **delights in the welfare** (*shalom*) **of his servant!**”

Isaiah 9:6 For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, **Prince of Peace.** (*shalom*)

Isaiah 32:17 And **the effect of righteousness will be peace** (*shalom*), and the **result of righteousness, quietness and trust** forever.

Isaiah 53:5 But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that **brought us peace** (*shalom*), and with his wounds we are healed.

Jeremiah 29:7 But seek the welfare (*shalom*) of the city where I have sent you into exile, and pray to the LORD on its behalf, for in its welfare (*shalom*) you will find your welfare (*shalom*).

Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans for welfare (*shalom*) and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope.

Ezekiel 37:26 I will make a covenant of peace (*shalom*) with them. It shall be an everlasting covenant with them. And I will set them in their land and multiply them, and will set my sanctuary in their midst forevermore.

Jeremiah 6:14 They have healed the wound of my people lightly, saying, ‘**Peace** (*shalom*), **peace** (*shalom*),’ when there is no **peace** (*shalom*).

Joel 2:25 I will **restore** (*shalom*) to you the years that the swarming locust has eaten, the hopper, the destroyer, and the cutter, my great army, which I sent among you.

Eirene: peace, tranquillity, unity, love of peace, every kind of blessing and good, safe, reconcile, friendly.

Luke 2:14 “Glory to God in the highest, and on earth **peace** among those with whom he is pleased!”

John 14:27 **Peace** I leave with you; **my peace** I give to you. **Not as the world gives** do I give to you. **Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid.**

John 16:33 I have said these things to you, that in me you may have **peace**. In the world **you will have tribulation**. But take heart; **I have overcome the world.**”

Romans 5:1 Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, **we have peace** with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Colossians 1:19-20 For in him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making **peace by the blood of his cross**.

Acts 9:31 So the church throughout all **Judea** and **Galilee** and **Samaria** had **peace** and was being **built up**. And walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, it multiplied.

Romans 14:19 So then let us **pursue what makes for peace** and for **mutual upbuilding**.

Philippians 4:6 do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.

Philippians 4:7 And the **peace of God**, which **surpasses all understanding**, will **guard your hearts** and **your minds in Christ Jesus**.

Colossians 3:15 And let the **peace of Christ rule in your hearts**, to which indeed you were called in **one body**. And **be thankful**.

2Thessalonians 3:16 Now may the **Lord of peace himself give you peace at all times in every way**. The Lord be with you all.

James 2:16 and one of you says to them, “**Go in peace**, be warmed and filled,” **without giving them the things needed for the body**, what good is that?

Ephesians 2:1 And **you were dead** in the trespasses and sins

Ephesians 2:4 **But God**, being rich in mercy, **because of the great love with which he loved us**,

Ephesians 2:5 even when we were **dead** in our trespasses, **made us alive** together with Christ—**by grace you have been saved**—

Ephesians 1:2 **Grace** to you and **peace** from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Ephesians 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has **blessed us in Christ** with **every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places**,

Ephesians 2:11 Therefore **remember** that at **one time** you **Gentiles** in the flesh, called “**the uncircumcision**” by what is called the **circumcision**, which is made in the **flesh by hands**—

*Romans 3:30 since **God** is one—who will justify the **circumcised by faith** and the **uncircumcised through faith**.*

*Romans 2:28 For **no one is a Jew** who is **merely one outwardly**, nor is **circumcision outward and physical**.*

*Romans 2:29 But a **Jew is one inwardly**, and **circumcision is a matter of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the letter**. His praise is not from man but from God.*

*Colossians 2:11 In him also you were **circumcised with a circumcision made without hands**, by putting off the body of the flesh, by the **circumcision of Christ**,*

*Galatians 3:28 There is neither **Jew** nor **Greek**, there is neither **slave** nor **free**, there is no **male** and **female**, for you are **all one in Christ Jesus**.*

Galatians 3:29 And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise.

Ephesians 2:12 **remember** that you (Gentiles) were at **that time separated from Christ**, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel and **strangers to the covenants of promise**, having **no hope and without God in the world**.

Ephesians 1:18-19 having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power toward us who believe, according to the working of his great might

Ephesians 2:13 **But now in Christ Jesus** you (Gentiles) who once were **far off** have been **brought near by the blood of Christ**.

Ephesians 2:14 For **he himself is our peace**, who has **made us both one** and has **broken down** in his flesh the **dividing wall of hostility**

Ephesians 2:15 **by abolishing the law of commandments expressed in ordinances**, that he might **create in himself one new man** in place of the two, so **making peace**,

Ephesians 2:16 and might **reconcile us both to God** in one body **through the cross**, thereby **killing the hostility (by removing dividing walls)**

Romans 5:1 Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Mark 15:38 And the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom.

Ephesians 2:17 And he came and preached **peace** to you who were far off and **peace** to those who were near.

Isaiah 57:19 creating the fruit of the lips. Peace, peace, to the far and to the near,” says the LORD, “and I will heal him.

Ephesians 2:18 For through him **we both have access in one Spirit to the Father.**

*Hebrews 4:16 Let us then with **confidence** draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.*

Ephesians 2:19 So then you are **no longer strangers and aliens**, but you are **fellow citizens** with the **saints and members of the household of God**,

*Hebrews 11:13 These all died in faith, not having received the things promised, but having seen them and greeted them from afar, and having **acknowledged that they were strangers and exiles on the earth.***

*Philippians 3:20 But our **citizenship is in heaven**, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ,*

*Colossians 1:13 **He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son,***

Romans 14:17 For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking but of righteousness and peace (Shalom) and joy in the Holy Spirit.

give you peace.**
