**Ephesians 2:11-22**

Psalms 133:1 Behold, how good and pleasant it is when **brothers dwell in unity!**

Genesis 1:26a Then God said, “**Let us** make man in **our image**, after **our likeness...**

Ephesians 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of **our** Lord Jesus Christ, who has **blessed us** in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places,

Ephesians 1:4 even as he **chose us** in him before the foundation of the world, that **we should be** holy and blameless before him. In love

Ephesians 1:5 **he predestined us** for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, **according to the purpose of his will**,

Ephesians 1:6 **to the praise of his glorious grace**, with which he has **blessed us** in the Beloved.

Ephesians 1:7 In him **we have** redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of **our trespasses**, according to the riches of his grace,

Ephesians 1:8 which he **lavished upon us**, in all wisdom and insight

Ephesians 1:9 making **known to us** the **mystery of his will**, according to his purpose, which he set forth in Christ

Ephesians 1:10 as a plan for the fullness of time, **to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth.**

Genesis 3:8 And they heard the sound of the **LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day**, and the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden.

Exodus 29:45 **I will dwell among the people** of Israel and **will be their God.**

Leviticus 26:12 And **I will walk among you and will be your God, and you shall be my people.**

Revelation 21:3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, “Behold, the **dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them** as their God.

Exodus 25:8 And let them make me a **sanctuary**, that **I may dwell in their midst.**

Exodus 33:7 Now Moses used to take the tent and pitch it **outside the camp, far off from the camp**, and he called it the **tent of meeting**. And everyone who sought the LORD would **go out to the tent of meeting**, which was **outside the camp**.

Exodus 40:34 Then the cloud covered the **tent of meeting**, and the **glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.**

Exodus 40:38 For the cloud of the LORD was on the tabernacle by day, and fire was in it by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel **throughout all their journeys.**

2Samuel 7:2 the king (David) said to Nathan the prophet, “See now, I dwell in a **house** of cedar, but the ark of **God dwells in a tent.**”

2Samuel 7:5 “Go and tell my servant David, ‘Thus says the LORD: **Would you build me a house to dwell in?**

2Samuel 7:6 I have not lived in a **house** since the day I brought up the people of Israel from Egypt to this day, but **I have been moving about in a tent for my dwelling.**

2Samuel 7:7 In all places where I have moved with all the people of Israel, did I speak a word with any of the judges of Israel, whom I commanded to shepherd my people Israel, saying, “**Why have you not built me a house of cedar?**””

2Samuel 7:12 When your days are fulfilled and you lie down with your fathers, **I will raise up your offspring after you**, who shall come from your body, and **I will establish his kingdom.**

2Samuel 7:13 **He shall build a house for my name**, and **I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.**

First Temple - Solomon

Second Temple - Zerubbabel

Herod’s Temple - 20 BC

Temple destroyed 70 A.D.

Matthew 4:5 Then the devil took him to the holy city and set him on the pinnacle of the **temple** (*hieron*)

Matthew 12:6 I tell you, something greater than the **temple** (*hieron*) is here.

John 2:19 Jesus answered them, “Destroy this temple (*naos*), and in three days I will raise it up.”

John 2:20 The Jews then said, “It has taken forty-six years to build this temple, and will you raise it up in three days?”

John 2:21 But he was speaking about the temple (*naos*) of his body.

Revelation 21:22 And I saw **no temple** (*naos*) in the city, for its **temple** (*naos*) is **the Lord God the Almighty and the Lamb.**

Ephesians 1:22 And he put all things under his feet and gave him as head over all things to **the church,**

Ephesians 1:23 **which is his body,** the fullness of him who fills all in all.

Ephesians 2:11 Therefore remember that at one time you **Gentiles** in the flesh, called “**the uncircumcision**” by what is called the **circumcision**, which is made in the flesh by hands—

Ephesians 2:12 remember that **you** were at that time **separated from Christ**, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers to the **covenants of promise**, having **no hope** and **without God in the world.**

Ephesians 2:13 **But now** in **Christ Jesus** you who once were **far off** have been **brought near by the blood of Christ.**

Ephesians 2:14 For **he himself is our peace**, who has made us **both one** and has **broken down in his flesh the dividing wall of hostility**

Ephesians 2:15 by **abolishing** (*released from*) **the law of commandments** expressed in ordinances, that he might **create in himself one new man** in place of the two, so **making peace,**

Ephesians 2:16 and might reconcile us both to God in **one body** through **the cross**, thereby killing the hostility.

Ephesians 2:17 And he came and preached **peace** to you who were **far off** and **peace** to those who were **near.**

Romans 5:1 Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have **peace with God** through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Ephesians 2:18 For through him we **both have access in one Spirit to the Father.**

Ephesians 2:19 So then you are **no longer strangers and aliens**, but you are **fellow citizens** with the saints and **members of the household** of God,

Ephesians 2:20 built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, **Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone,**

Ephesians 2:21 in whom the **whole structure**, being joined together, grows into a **holy temple (*naos*) in the Lord.**

Ephesians 2:22 In him **you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit.**

1Peter 2:4 As you come to him, a **living stone rejected by men** but in the sight of **God chosen and precious,**

1Peter 2:5 you yourselves like **living stones are being built up as a spiritual house**, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

Hebrews 13:15 Through him then let us continually offer up a **sacrifice of praise** to God, that is, the fruit of lips that acknowledge his name.

1Peter 2:6 For it stands in Scripture: “Behold, I am laying in Zion a stone, a cornerstone chosen and precious, and **whoever believes in him will not be put to shame.**”

1Peter 2:7 So the honor is for you **who believe**, but for **those who do not believe**, “The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone,”

1Peter 2:8 and “**A stone of stumbling, and a rock of offense.**” They stumble because they disobey the word, as they were destined to do.

1Peter 2:9 But you are a **chosen race**, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, **that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.**

1Peter 2:10 Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but **now you have received mercy.**

1Corinthians 3:16 Do you not know that you are God's temple (*naos*) and that God's Spirit dwells in you?

1Corinthians 6:19 Or do you not know that your body is a temple (*naos*) of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own,

2Corinthians 6:16 What agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we are the temple (*naos*) of the living God; as God said, **"I will make my dwelling among them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.**

Acts 17:24 The God who made the world and everything in it, being Lord of heaven and earth, does not live in **temples** (*naos*) made by man,

Acts 17:25 nor is he served by human hands, as though he needed anything, since he himself gives to all mankind life and breath and everything.

Acts 18:3 and because he was of the same trade he stayed with them and worked, for **they were tentmakers** by trade.

2Samuel 7:6 I have not lived in a **house** since the day I brought up the people of Israel from Egypt to this day, but **I have been moving about in a tent for my dwelling.**

1Corinthians 12:27 Now you are the **body of Christ** and **individually members of it.**
