I want to welcome you to PCPC. We know there's a lot in this Fall Guide, but we hope it's more than a menu, more than a flood of information. We want to shepherd you toward being a healthy member or participant in the life of our church.

Connect to Christ AND ONE ANOTHER

In John 15, Jesus gives us a beautiful vision of a healthy group of believers. Drawing from the rich biblical imagery of God's people being like a vineyard, Jesus reveals Himself as "the true vine," the only one in whom true life is found (v. 1). And if we are connected to Jesus by faith, we are also immediately and intimately connected with every other believer as fellow branches (v. 5). Therefore, the most foundational thing we do is to be God's means to connect people to Christ and His Church personally.

At PCPC, we have a wide variety of ministries that are designed to help you connect to Christ together with other believers with whom you have something in common. If you are not already engaged in one of these ministries, we hope God will lead you into one this fall.

Abide in Christ

The most repeated word in John 15 is, "abide." With this word Jesus gives us a promise leading towards a calling. To abide in Christ means to live with Him (promise) so that we would become like Him (calling). Or in doctrinal terms, from our union with Christ (justification) flows deliberate and fruitful communion with Christ (sanctification). For us as a church, this means we abide in Jesus through His Word, the sacraments, and prayer so that we may experience and extend His transforming presence in our lives.

At PCPC, we seek to develop resources to help believers abide in Christ individually, as families, and as a congregation. We hope you will make use of some of these materials, events, and ministries as you seek to abide in Christ and serve His Church.

Extend Christ

One of the great surprises of John 15 is that Jesus entrusts His mission as the vine to us as branches. Just as the Father appointed Him, so now Jesus has appointed us (vv. 15-16). This means extending His self-sacrificial love to one another (vv. 12-13, 17). And this means going out to proclaim that the Kingdom of God has come in Jesus Christ, and to pray that God would bear much fruit through us (vv. 15-16). For us as a church, this means the third and most far-reaching thing we do is to extend Christ.
