

PCPC Phase Two Childcare Safety

With careful planning, we're excited to announce that a limited number of spots for 0-4 year old children are open! Here are the additional steps we are taking to keep our children's environments safe (and fun) for your family.

- We've increased hygiene and cleaning protocols in our kids' spaces during and between services.
- Additional hand-sanitizing stations will be available in each of our areas.
- All volunteers will wear masks.
- We will sanitize all toys and hard surfaces before every service.
- We ask that children leave all personal toys and any extra items at home to prevent cross-contamination.

When you arrive, be ready for a redesigned check-in process to help support a safe environment outlined below:

- Like our weekend adult services, pre-registration will be required.
- Entry to Phase Two childcare is exclusively at the Wycliff Ave ramp. Please do not access the Children's area from another entry.
- Every adult and child will have their temperature taken before entry into the childcare area. We will not be able to admit anyone with a temperature of 100 degrees or higher.
- We have a touchless check-in experience where a designated person will check-in your children with a parent present.
- Only one parent (1) should enter into the kids' areas for drop off and pickup to help limit traffic in the hallways. It is highly recommended that the same parent do drop-off and pick-up.
- Take potty trained children to the restroom before you drop off.
- Please send a labeled sippy cup or cup with your child.
- You'll see lots of friendly hand waves, but let's avoid hugs, high-fives, and handshakes.

We'll all need to work together to help keep our kids safe, so please stay home and participate in PCPC services online if you or your child:

- Has had a fever (100 degrees or higher) in the past seven days;
- Lost of taste or smell;
- Shortness of breath, coughing, or difficulty breathing;
- Is experiencing chills, vomiting, sudden onset of a headache, or diarrhea;
- Has been exposed to anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in past 14 days.

Please understand there is still an element of risk you accept when we gather, but we are following these protocols to keep our church family and community as safe as we can.
