## Kids Ministry Safety Protocols

We're excited to announce that our new children's space is open for ministry programs! There are a limited number of spots for 3 months to 4<sup>th</sup> grade. Below are the additional steps we are taking to keep our ministry spaces safe. Placing your child in childcare is operating at your own risk.

- We've increased hygiene and cleaning protocols in our kids' spaces during and between services.
- Additional hand-sanitizing stations will be available in each of our areas.
- All volunteers will wear masks.
- We will sanitize all toys and hard surfaces before every service.
- We ask that children leave all personal toys and any extra items at home to prevent cross-contamination.

When you arrive, be ready for a redesigned check-in process to help support a safe environment outlined below:

- Pre-registration will be required for all kids. This helps ensure we have the right number of volunteers and ample space.
- Entry to our new Children's space is through the lower level parking garage or surface level parking on the south end of the church campus.
- All adults (parent and volunteer) and elementary-aged children will need to properly mask prior to entering Kids Ministry spaces.
- Check-in is as normal; use the last 4 digits of your cell phone number. Nametags and pick-up receipts are required for drop-off and pick-up.
- We suggest only one (1) parent enter the kids' areas for drop-off and pick-up to help limit traffic in the hallways. It is highly recommended that the same parent does drop-off and pick-up.
- We request parents take potty trained children to the restroom before you drop-off.
- You'll see lots of friendly hand waves, but let's avoid hugs, high-fives, and handshakes.

We all need to work together to help keep our kids safe, so please stay home and participate in PCPC services online ([pcpc.org/live](https://pcpc.org/live)) if you or your child:

- Has had a fever (100 degrees or higher) in the past 7 days
- Loss of taste or smell
- Shortness of breath, coughing, or difficulty breathing
- Is experiencing chills, vomiting, sudden onset of a headache, or diarrhea
- Has been exposed to anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days
