Reflect

Do you believe that Jesus is just as interested as what he is doing in as he is doing through you? What motivates you to pass on the good news? Does your evangelism flow from a spirit of joy?

Think about one or two non-believers in your life (neighbor, friend, relative, co-worker, international student, etc.). Write out what you know about their story. What is their background? What are their desires? What



are the hurting, broken, and messy places in their lives? How might you communicate the hope of the gospel in a way that resonates with their story? What passages of Scripture would you bring before them? Take time to pray for these people. Pray for opportunities to share the gospel with them. Pray that they would join you at church. Pray that God would draw them to Himself.

Think through some ways that your church community (your Small Group, Bible Study, etc.) could participate in evangelism together. Who could you invite to participate in your community? In what ways could you be intentional as a community to reach out? What needs can you, as a community, meet?
